Bronze powders are usually dusted on a surface that has been coated with some suitable agglutinant to cause the powder to adhere, in some cases a bronze paint is used, while, in the case of leather articles, a liquid or bronzing fluid is employed. Such a fluid is one of the easiest methods of bronzing because the fluid is similar to a quick-drying varnish, that, when dry, exhibits a bronzed effect, which is generally due to the presence of a superabundance of an aniline dye. Success in the art of bronzing greatly depends on circumstances, such as the temperature of the alloy (metallic bronzing powder) or...
